though some prices had already started moving earlier. Prices declined by €30-40/t, and sometimes even more. At the same time, pricing remains inconsitent. All kinds of prices exist, comments one respondent, describing the situation as anarchy.

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The greatest price pressure seems to have built up in the uncoated fine paper segment, particularly for cut sizes. The larger pool of suppliers than in coated grades as well as the competition from non-European imports are noticeable here.

Yet, there are also low-priced offers from European production. For woodfree uncoated offset reels, the lowest offers are around $\in 800/t$, while prices as high as $\in 1,000/t$ are also still being paid. The corresponding quotes for folio sheets are $\in 70-80/t$ higher.

The price trend for coated woodfree paper had been somewhat more stable, but prices have

been cut here too, say market insiders. Prices for coated reel paper start around €900/t, but can still reach €1,000/t. Similar price brackets are seen for coated sheets.

In terms of demand, June was not a bad month, according to insiders on the French market. As is often the case, business then quieted down from mid-July, and demand is not expected to rebound during August, when most of France is on holiday. Prices are also unlikely to move much, simply because of the lack of business activity, players explain. Summer discounts are not really an issue right now since low-priced offers and special prices existed throughout the entire year, EUWID was told.

The market for woodfree uncoated and coated paper continues to be shaped by the current capacity overhang and shrinking consumption. Producers feel hard-pressed as they have to simultaneously contend with insufficient capaci-

ty utilisation, cost pressure and price pressure. Further capacity closures are needed to restore balance between supply and demand, insiders believe. However, it is also very expensive to close or mothball a mill, so producers must weigh this against the financials of their paper sales, explained one producer. In some cases, it could be more financially viable for a papermaker to sell paper at break-even prices or even at a loss for a while.

Newsprint prices often unchanged, magazine papers under pressure

On the market for publication paper in France, the ink is dry on the new quarterly and half-year contracts. Negotiations often resulted in unchanged prices for newsprint as well as unchanged or slightly lower prices for magazine paper.

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
